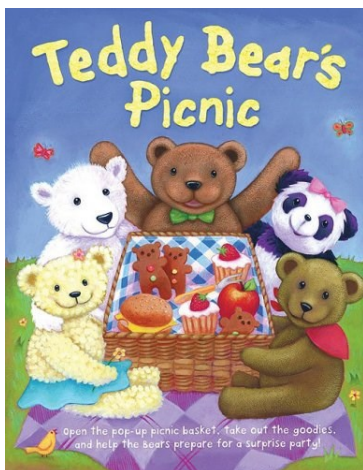
This year we are excited to have a new venue at Balance. Sessions will be in the 25m pool and the change rooms nearest the pool will be only for our students.
