All students from kindergarten to year 6 are encouraged to dress up as their favourite book character for this event. We would like to invite all families to come and enjoy this celebration.

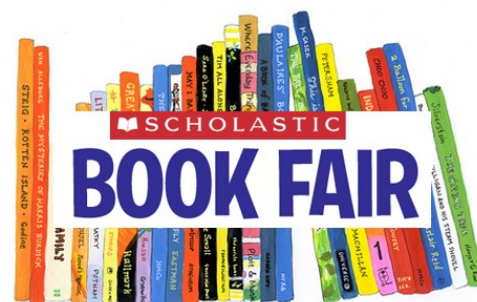
Book Fair

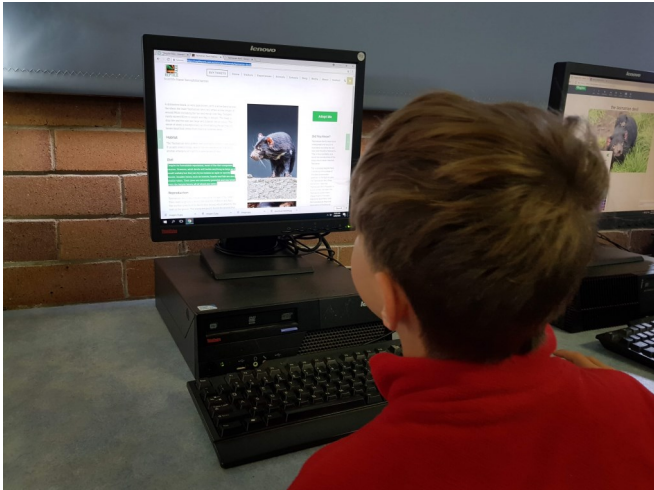


From the Classroom..... 4/5R

4/5R will be showcasing some wonderful 'Glogsters' as part of their assembly item this week - Stay tuned!



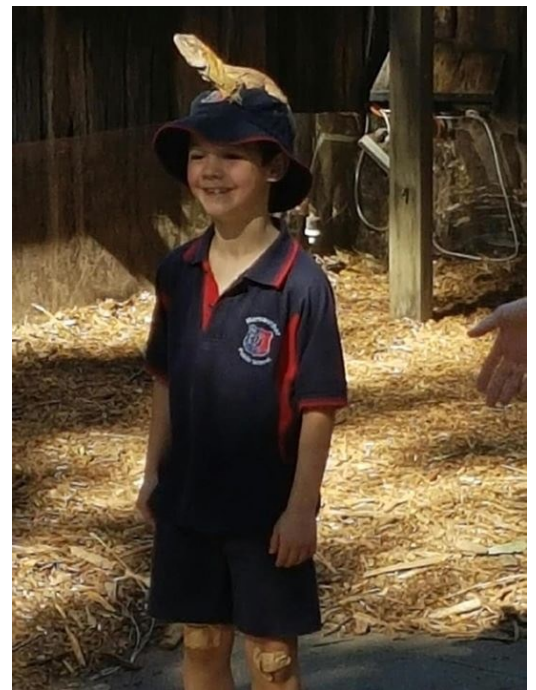


Infants Excursion to the Reptile Park
